Symptom

The following symptoms have been identified in the **Cret@: Fichero de Bases** (RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES) report after the application of SAP Note 2005468 (CRETA: Bases File):

1. You are running the **Cret@: fichero de bases** (RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES) report for an employee with a common illness relapse (recaída de IT) and the program generates duplicated contributions, which some of them have empty values.
2. You run the **Cret@: fichero de bases** (RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES) report and you press F1 on the **Clave de autorización** (P_AUTORC) field, but it does not have any documentation.
3. The report generates overlapped intervals (tramos) if the employee has two consecutive absences and benefits (prestaciones).
4. You have implemented a BADI to use with **Cret@: fichero de bases** (RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES) report, but when you are running the report it is generated an error message in the Log into General Messages node.
5. The report generated a **Tramo** (<Tramo>) tag with both **DatosTramo** (<DatosTramo>) and **MarcaBorrado** (<MarcaBorrado>) tags.
6. A short dump (GETWA_NOT_ASSIGNED) may occur when running the report for an employee with consecutive absences.
7. You run the report for an employee with an **Exención de recargo en liquid.complementarias** (PCMAT) informed in **Seguridad Social (ES)** (0061) infotype and with **non-taken vacations**. Instead of generating an **Vacaciones retribuidas y no disfrutadas** (L13) liquidation, it generates the liquidation corresponding to the informed PCMAT (L02 or L03).
8. You run the report with the **Reportar diferencias** (HRPAYES_CRETA_RETRO) option for an employee with retroactive changes to their **non-taken vacations** amounts. A L13 liquidation is generated in the same file as an additional settlement and thus is rejected.
9. Additional settlements might incorrectly report contribution intervals containing only a **Modalidad de Salario** (51) indicator set to value **Modalidad mensual** (M).

Other Terms

Reason and Prerequisites

1. The issue is caused by a program error in the RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES report. The program creates a contribution even if there is no amount to report.
2. The issue is caused by a program error in the RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES report. The **Clave de autorización** (P_AUTORC) field is a **Campo de caracteres long.8** (CHAR8) data element instead of a **Clave de autorización para el sistema RED** (PB04_AUTOR) data element.
3. The issue occurs due to incorrect evaluation of the original begin date of the absences.
4. The issue is caused by a program error in RPCPAYES_CRETA_PAYDATA_CIMP include.
5. **DatosTramo** and **MarcaBorrado** tags are mutually exclusive and should not be reported in the same **Interval**.
6. The issue is caused by a program error in RPCPAYES_CRETA_CONTRIB_C_CIMP include.
7. The report was treating the L13 liquidation as an additional settlement.
8. In this case, should not be generated the L13.
9. The issue is caused by a program error in the RPCPAYES_CRETA_INTERVAL_C_CIMP include.

Solution

1. Corrections to source code of RPCPAYES_CRETA_CONTRIB_C_CIMP include have been provided to solve this issue. The report avoids the generation of empty contributions in case of absence relapse.
2. The following objects have been changed in this correction: RPCPAYES_CRETA_UI_CDEF, RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES_FORM and, RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES_SCREEN includes.
3. Now the report correctly generates the XML file.
4. Corrections to source code of RPCPAYES_CRETA_CONTRIB_C_CIMP include have been provided to solve this issue.
5. Now, when the **MarcaBorrado** is reported, the **Interval Data** is not.
6. Corrections to source code of RPCPAYES_CRETA_CONTRIB_C_CIMP include have been provided to solve this issue.
7. Now, arrears exemption are not reported in regular liquidations neither in non taken vacation liquidations.
8. Corrections to source code of RPCPAYES_CRETA_PAYDATA_C_CIMP include have been provided to solve this issue. Now, L13 liquidations are not generated together with other additional settlements, except in the period selected in the report selection screen.
9. Corrections to source code of the RPCPAYES_CRETA_INTERVAL_C_CIMP include have been provided to solve this issue. From now on, the report deletes those intervals from additional settlements that contain only the 51 indicator.
