

Symptom

The following symptom was identified in report **SLD: Bases File** (RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES):

- The report is not generating an interval required by the Social Insurance, therefore the file is rejected by the Social Insurance validation software.

Environment

- Human Capital Management (HCM)
- SAP R/3
- SAP ERP Core Component
- SAP ERP
- SAP enhancement package for SAP ERP
- SAP enhancement package for SAP ERP, version for SAP HANA

Reproducing the Issue

- Run payroll
- Run SLD Bases File

Cause

There are two reasons that could cause this issue:

1- Additional spaces (blank characters) in table T77PAYES_RELAP.

To check this point, please follow these steps:

- Run transaction SM30 to display the view V_T77PAYES_RELAP.
- For each entry table, do click at the right of the content of columns "Cluster/Inf." and "Field Name".

If the cursor shows spaces between the text and the end of line, then it is an error, the entry is not going to be identified by the report:

2- In some cases, SLD Bases File report unifies payroll results splits in just one interval, this is right and it happens because the contribution conditions do not change from one split to the other one. Despite this functionality, a user could require the generation of an interval in these situations, however fields on table T77PAYES_RELAP are not enough to generate an interval, because the data on those fields did not change in the payroll results splits.

Resolution

1- To eliminate the spaces on table T77PAYES_RELAP follow these steps:

- Run transaction SM30.
- Delete the wrong entry (write down the values of the fields previously).
- Create the new entry avoiding blank characters at the end of the text.

2- It is possible to customize personnel actions to indicate a new relationship with the Social Insurance institution. This is done on view V_T5E30

field “**Barr. nom.**” (BARNOM), it generates a new interval when running SLD Bases File report. For more information about this point, please see note 2039217.
