Symptom

You are running the **SLD: Fichero de bases** (RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES) report for an employee that has an absence. The interval related to the absence is not generated in the Bases file. The file is refused by the Spanish Social Insurance.

Other Terms

&SLD - PC00_M04_CRETA_BASES (for more information, see SAP Note 1071282)
Absentismo; Tramo;

Reason and Prerequisites

The issue is caused by a program error.

When checking if the absence is relevant, the report uses the absence **Regla de valoración** (T554S-KLBEW) field to get the **Tipo de absentismo/presencia** (T554Q-ABSTY) value. Then, it matches the field T554Q-ABSTY with all entries from T5ECP, where T5ECP-SIMBO or T5ECP-COLIS are equal to T554Q-ABSTY. If entries are found, it uses the T554Q-ABSTY field to identify if an absence is relevant and should generate an interval in the Bases file.

However, if multiple T554Q-ABSTY entries exist for the same T554Q-KLBEW, the report uses the last entry in T554Q for the given KLBEW to check if the absence is relevant. That may result in a T554Q-ABSTY value that does not have related concepts, even when the absence is relevant.

The correct way to check if an absence is relevant is to use the **Símbolo de absentismo** (T5ECP-SIMBO) field instead.

EXAMPLE

T554S

SUBTY	KLBEW
1000	13

T554Q

ABSTY	KLBEW
3	13
8	13

T5ECP

ABSTP	SIMBO	COLIS
N	N	X
N	E	W
N	1	7
N	3	8

When processing this absence, the last entry of T554Q would be used. As T554Q-ABSTY equals to 8, and there are no related concept for this value, the absence is ignored and no interval is generated.

Solution

Corrections to source code of RPCPAYES_CRETA_ABSENCE_C_CIMP include have been provided to solve this issue.

Now, the RPC_PAYES_CRETA_BASES report uses the T5ECP-SIMBO field to get the related concepts for the absence and should generate an interval.

Using the previous example, the report would get the T5ECP-SIMBO field for that absence. As T5ECP-SIMBO equals to 3, and there are related concepts for this value, the absence interval is generated correctly.
