Symptom

The behavior of the options Período En igual al período de cálculo de nómina (P_CURRES) and Período En igual o anterior al período de cálculo de nómina (P_ANYRES) in the Conceptos Retributivos Abonados (RPC_PAYES_CRA) report may not be clear if you have the Período desfasado (SPDES) customer situation active.

Reason and Prerequisites

This issue is a side effect caused by the enablement of the support to Período desfasado functionality in RPC_PAYES_CRA report.

The following Support Package level is the minimum prerequisite:

Solution

Corrections to source code of RPC_PAYES_CRA report have been provided to solve this issue. From now on, the behavior of P_CURRES and P_ANYRES options will be as follows:

- If you run the report with a Período de Liquidación range completely before SPDES activation, you are able to choose one of these 2 options, since it makes sense to apply this payroll result filtering options when the Período Desfasado functionality is not active.
- If you run the report with a Período de Liquidación range completely after SPDES activation, you are not able to choose any of these 2 options, since the control of the payroll periods to be reported by the report should be done through the entries of Directorio de resultados de nómina utilizados en el TC (T5EC1) table.

- Running the report with a Período de Liquidación range before and after SPDES activation will let you choose one of these 2 options. However, please take into account the option selected will only be considered when reporting the payroll periods data that is previous to the SPDES customer situation activation.

For example, please consider the following scenarios:

- SPDES activation: 01.03.2016
 - Período de Liquidacion: 10.2015 a 12.2015
 - Both P_CURRES and P_ANYRES options are available to be selected.
 - Período de Liquidacion: 10.2015 a 04.2016
 - Both P_CURRES and P_ANYRES options are also available to be selected, but will only be used for liquidation periods 10.2015 until 02.2016.
 - Período de Liquidación: 03.2016 a 04.2016
 - Both P_CURRES and P_ANYRES options are unavailable to be selected, since the control of which payroll periods should be reported will be done through T5EC1 table.
